

CONFLICT MINERALS POLICY

Bellamy Precision agrees with the widely accepted principle in the industry, according to which it is necessary to deal with problems related to social responsibility in the entire supply chain.

We support the initiative of international organizations and companies regarding the lack of raw materials from countries affected by armed conflicts. The following minerals are referred to as "conflict materials": tantalum, tin, tungsten and gold (3TG).


They are an integral part of many technologies that we use every day, but are nevertheless used to finance armed groups in countries affected by armed conflicts - the Democratic Republic of the Congo and neighbouring countries.

Bellamy Precision is against the use of materials originating from zones of armed conflict and materials of doubtful or unknown origin.

Bellamy Precision does not order raw materials, goods and components from areas subject to armed conflicts directly and according to our state of knowledge, based on dialogue with our suppliers, we believe that the material we use does not come from these regions.

Bellamy Precision will strive to ensure that our suppliers purchase materials from sources that respect human rights and environmental protection.

Bellamy Precision also reserves that it will not cooperate with suppliers operating in a manner inconsistent with this policy.
